Do I Need A TV Licence?

- You will receive a large fine if you do not buy a television licence, and you may well be prosecuted.
- If you live in shared accommodation or have signed a joint tenancy agreement then only one licence is needed to cover any amount of TV's in the accommodation.
- If you have signed an individual agreement and therefore live in a separately occupied area you need licences for each persons TV.
- If you are lodging you need a licence for your own TV, as you will not be covered by any licence the accommodation's owner may have.

How to Pay?

Cash Easy Entry Scheme?

- If you are on income-related state benefits, or cannot afford to/do not want to pay for the whole TV licence in one go, then you can pay using the Cash Easy Entry scheme. The scheme allows you to pay weekly or fortnightly cash payments towards your licence
- You must keep paying regularly to stay on this scheme.
- If you join you will get a payment card and dates when your payments are due. You can pay at post offices or Paypoint outlets.

One-off payment or monthly payments by direct debit from your bank account or over the phone with your debit/credit card.
